The project "Green compass for Europe" aims to empower youth for a sustainable future by providing them with knowledge and examples how they can change the way they live, and contribute to the more sustainable and environmental friendly future, provide with already existing eco-friendly behaviors, also, to raise environmental awareness on the current global climate challenge, on the existing initiatives, ideas and programs and on the impact of everyday choices. It seeks to encourage youth to become local sustainability ambassadors.

First TPM in Passignano sul Trasimeno



The first transnational meeting took place on the 29th and 30th of September 2022. The consortium met in Passignano sul Trasimeno (Italy) and after a brief introduction and partners presentation, the team discussed the first project result and designed a plan for the tasks related to the first output.
